

Murray Napier Fund administered by St Columba's, Pont Street, London, the Appeal Fund has now passed £50,000 and grateful thanks are due to everyone who has contributed in any way thus far. Donations can still be made at any time and details can be found on a blue flyer by the model of the church in the chancel, or on our website. Plans are still being made for the major works required to the roof, walls and windows in due course but interim work is currently being carried out on the stonework around the staircase window.
